NOTICE TO ALL JUSTICES OF THE PEACE

THE JUSTICE OF THE PEACE REGULATIONS 2015, SETS OUT THE CODE OF CONDUCT FOR JUSTICES OF THE PEACE IN THE CAYMAN ISLANDS.

JUSTICES OF THE PEACE ARE REQUIRED TO KEEP A WRITTEN RECORD OF ANY SERVICE PROVIDED IN ANY REAL PROPERTY TRANSACTION, IN THE ISSUING OF A WARRANT, ANY ATTESTATION OF DOCUMENTS OR IN ANY OTHER WAYS THAT SIGNATURES ARE WITNESSED OR IDENTITIES CERTIFIED. A RECORD MUST ALSO NEED TO BE KEPT OF ALL OCCASIONS ON WHICH JUSTICE OF THE PEACE SERVICES ARE REFUSED AND THE REASONS FOR REFUSING.

JUSTICES OF THE PEACE WHO WISH TO CONTINUE TO UNDERTAKE THE DUTIES OF THIS OFFICE MUST SUBMIT THEIR RECORDS TO THE CLERK OF THE COURT ON AN ANNUAL BASIS, AS REQUIRED BY LAW. JUSTICES OF THE PEACE ARE INVITED TO SUBMIT ALL THEIR OUTSTANDING RECORDS TO THE CLERK OF THE COURT NO LATER THAN 28 FEBRUARY 2025, AND SUBSEQUENT RECORDS ON THE 31ST DECEMBER OF EACH YEAR.

THE RECORDS ADDRESSED TO THE CLERK OF COURT SHOULD BE HAND DELIVERED TO THE LAW COURTS AT HEROES SQUARE, GEORGE TOWN, GRAND CAYMAN, CAYMAN ISLANDS.
